How it Works: It is an educational program for practitioners who will serve as mock arbitrators for arbitration "rounds."

Subject Matter: The Problem involves a controversy arising out of an international sale of goods subject to the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (CISG). The controversy is before an arbitral tribunal pursuant to the Hamburg Arbitration Rules of the Chinese European Arbitration Centre (CEAC). The parties have agreed that the arbitration will be held in Vindobona, Danubia. Danubia has enacted the UNCITRAL Model Law on International Commercial Arbitration (Model Law) with the 2006 amendments. Danubia, Equatoriana, and Mediterraneo, three of the four states that are, or may be, involved are parties to the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (New York Convention). Equatoriana, Mediterraneo, and Oceania are all parties to the Convention on the Worst Forms of Child Labour.
